

MISSION

Out Front Theatre Company's mission is to tell LGBTQIA+ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Questioning, Intergender, Asexual) stories.

VISION

Out Front Theatre Company's vision is to strengthen the LGBTQIA+ community in Georgia by exploring and celebrating the universal human experience through the lens of gender and sexuality.

EQUALITY, DIVERSITY, & INCLUSION COMMITMENT

The staff and board of Out Front Theatre Company want to put the following metrics in place so that we can track them to completion. We want our stakeholders and our patrons to see real results.

- We want to have representative board members from black and brown communities, as well as gender nonconforming representatives and increase that representation by at least 10% every year until we reach a goal of above 50%.
- We want to produce, support, or promote at least 2 shows/events from creatives of color every year and increase that number by at least 20% every year.
- We want to increase our presence in communities of color and in women's communities through intentional outreach. We can do this by creating a communication strategy to expand our patronage. To that end, we will recruit a community outreach intern or staff member to help achieve this goal.
- We want to increase our intersectional involvement by partnering with other socially progressive nonprofit organizations to collaborate on community events. The goal is to have at least one partner event per year with an ultimate goal of three per year.

Dramaturgy

Many queer folk first discover their tribe through the nightclub scene. For Ryan Landry, playwright of *Murder on the Polar Express*, this is where he first discovered his brand of theatre. Landry's foray into theatrical performance was through bars in NYC's grungy Lower East Side (yes, think *RENT*) in the 80s and 90s. He was a regular at the Pyramid Club in the East Village, also frequented by RuPaul Charles and Lady



Bunny. He would perform in musical parodies and silly variety acts often on bar tops. Well, that is until his speciality act misfired. Jumping through flaming hoops dressed as a 'Flying Nun' he accidentally caught the bar on fire. Needless to say, he was never invited back. But through his 40+ year career and the 80+ plays he has written and starred in, his frenetic energy and anarchic sense of play have remained his signature. This quality fuels *Murder...* as a vehicle for Christmas pastiche with Agatha Christie plots, musical classics, a caboose full of raucous campy holiday characters.



Within the nightclub setting, Landry's theatre was a natural fit; a space to celebrate pop music that was also primed for improvisation and playful audience interaction. And, not to forget, copious alcohol to help lubricate the festivities. While hustling as a

downtown theatre artist, he created his low-art magnum opus: "Booger Drag." The unabashedly cheap cross-dressing style was a hodgepodge of thrifting and trash. It was matched with his irreverent persona, likely a nod to drag legend Divine's acerbic wit. His characteristically downtown approach successfully defied NYC's stuffy arts scene uptown.

Dramaturgy (CONTINUED)

In the mid-1980s, Landry met one of his greatest artistic influences: champion of queer downtown theatre, Charles Ludlam. As an avid fan of his Ridiculous Theatrical Company, Landry was eventually asked to join as an ensemble member and spent two years until Ludlam's tragic death from AIDS in 1987. Landry's plays are, in part, an homage to the Ridiculous' wild pop culture parodies. The scripts were often sendups of Hollywood



classics, replete with literary references and gay innuendo, mixed in with plenty of drag. They were also vehicles for social commentary through humor. For Landry, he has continually worked to push the envelope of political correctness. In lieu of *Legally Blonde: The Musical*, he wrote and starred in *Legally Blind, the "Helen Keller Musical"* (his Annie Sullivan modeled after *Gypsy's* Mama-Rose). It might make you laugh-or cringebut for Landry that's the point. Queer scholar, Helen Lewis, describes him perhaps best as an "undeviating deviant," intentionally refusing to comply with the expectations of the mainstream.



Check out Landry's if you make it to Ptown during the summer months. For decades, he has hosted the weekly Monday night "Show Girls" variety competition, also featuring a guest celebrity co-host. In the winter months, you'll likely find Landry up to his usual antics in the Boston

area, typically in his home of choice, a nightclub. As resident playwright and performer of the Gold Dust Orphans company, he'll be serving up original thriller spoofs and musical pastiche. *Murder on the Polar Express* debuted in 2016 with Landry as Detective Shirley Holmes, and what a better way to slay the holidays than with their latest 2024 holiday fare, *Rosemary's Baby Jesus*. Think Roman Polanski, but with a gay twist...

- Create artistic and educational opportunities for at-risk LGBTQIA+ youths by collaborating with local educational institutions and organizations,
- *Expand* the number of theatrical opportunities for artists who are members of or who support the LGBTQIA+ community.

Out Front hopes to create a narrative that will reach beyond the stage, into the

conversations and minds our audiences and artists. Theatre's power as a catalyst to spur dialogues goes back thousands of years. Out Front lives to continue that grand tradition of bringing the stories of the LGBTQIA+ people into the spotlight.

LGBTQIA+ Definitions

L stands for Lesbian: Term used to describe female identified people attracted romantically, erotically, and/or emotionally to other female identified people.

G stands for Gay: Term used in some cultural settings to represent male identified people who are attracted to other male identified people in a romantic, erotic and/or emotional sense. Also, a term used to refer to the LGBTQIA+ community as a whole or as an individual identity label for anyone who does not identify as heterosexual.

B stands for Bisexual: A person emotionally, physically, and/or sexually attracted to people of more than one sex and/or gender. This attraction does not have to be equally split between genders and there may be a preference for one gender over others.

T stands for Transgender: A person who lives as a member of a gender other than that expected based on anatomical sex. Sexual orientation varies and is not dependent on gender identity. This term is sometimes used to refer to the gender variant community as a whole. **O stands for Queer:** An umbrella term, which embraces a matrix of sexual preferences, orientations, and habits of the not-exclusively-heterosexual-andmonogamous majority. Queer includes lesbians, gays, bisexuals, transpeople, intersex persons, and many other sexually transgressive explorers. The term is sometimes used as a sexual orientation label instead of 'bisexual' as a way of acknowledging that there are more than two genders to be attracted to, or as a way of stating a non-heterosexual orientation without having to state who they are attracted to.

I stands for Intergender: Intergender people have a gender identity that is in the middle between the binary genders of female and male, and may be a mix of both.

A stands for Asexual: A term describing individuals who do not experience sexual attraction or do not have interest in or desire for sex. Asexuality is different from celibacy, which means abstaining from sex. Asexuality is often viewed as a spectrum - meaning there are varying levels and identities regarding someone's emotional, spiritual and romantic attraction. The best way to refer to the asexual community is to use the umbrella term "ace" or "aces" as in the "ace community," which acknowledges that spectrum.

+ stands for Many Other Identifications

including, but not limited to pansexual, genderqueer, polysexual, agender, androsexual, demisexual, and skoliosexual. We strive to be as inclusive as we can and know we can always improve.


