#### **Director's Note**

It is with deep pride and personal resonance that I direct *Immediate Family* by Paul Oakley Stovall. As a director, I am continually drawn to theater's unique ability to tell universal stories through deeply personal experiences. This play touches on themes of family, identity, and the courageous act of love in the face of both support and resistance. In many ways, it echoes



my own experience when I introduced my boyfriend to my very religious family–an unplanned and overwhelming moment. But, as *Immediate Family* so beautifully reminds us, love and acceptance are often forged in vulnerability, and the path to understanding is rarely straightforward or predictable.

Being a part of this production has been a profound honor, and I am incredibly grateful for the opportunity to witness the transformation of this ensemble as they brought these multi-dimensional, complex characters to life. One of the things I sought to instill early in our rehearsal process was a sense of authenticity and connection. To foster this, I invited the cast to contribute items from their childhoods–a personal artifact, a symbol of home, something that represented the essence of who they are and where they come from. The result was a small shrine of memories–a tangible reminder of how family and history shape us, both on and off the stage.

Our rehearsals were full of vulnerability and spirited debates, but they also fostered bonds that extended far beyond the work itself. A key part of our process was a series of bid whist games, led by our coach, DJ Miami Rosay. In the heat of competition–filled with laughter and the occasional disagreement–we grew closer as a team. These games became a metaphor for the challenges our characters face–sometimes tough, sometimes messy, but always pushing forward with a shared sense of community.

Just as my family embarked on a journey when I brought home an unexpected guest, Evie, Tony, Jesse, Nina, Kristian and Ronnie are all beginning their own journeys–a journey that unfolds before your eyes. Reflecting on my own family's relationship with my now-husband, I find it hard to believe how far we've come. Teenage me could never have imagined that this kind of acceptance was possible.

I hope that *Immediate Family* resonates with you, as it has with all of us. It is a play that celebrates the complexities of love and family, while acknowledging the strength required to navigate the difficult yet beautiful process of acceptance.

- We want to increase our presence in communities of color and in women's communities through intentional outreach. We can do this by creating a communication strategy to expand our patronage. To that end, we will recruit a community outreach intern or staff member to help achieve this goal.
- We want to increase our intersectional involvement by partnering with other socially progressive nonprofit organizations to collaborate on community events. The goal is to have at least one partner event per year with an ultimate goal of three per year.

Out Front Theatre Company was established to tell stories of the LGBTQIA+ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intergender, Asexual) experience and community, giving voice to LGBTQIA+ authors, composers, artists, and creators through the medium of theatre and the performing arts. Out Front plans to develop new works and produce classic pieces of theatre that have communicated these stories of the LGBTQIA+ population to a wider audience over time.

As a non-profit organization with a dedicated focus to better the LGBTQIA+ population, we strive to:

- Produce established works and premiere productions created by members of the LGBTQIA+ society,
- Generate productions with universal themes which are important to the LGBTQIA+ community,
- Educate the populous to LGBTQIA+ history,
- Work with local and national LGBTQIA+ organizations to bring awareness of issues facing the LGBTQIA+ to the greater Atlanta area,
- Create artistic and educational opportunities for at-risk LGBTQIA+ youths by collaborating with local educational institutions and organizations,
- *Expand* the number of theatrical opportunities for artists who are members of or who support the LGBTQIA+ community.

Out Front hopes to create a narrative that will reach beyond the stage, into the

conversations and minds our audiences and artists. Theatre's power as a catalyst to spur dialogues goes back thousands of years. Out Front lives to continue that grand tradition of bringing the stories of the LGBTQIA+ people into the spotlight.

#### LGBTQIA+ Definitions

L stands for Lesbian: Term used to describe female identified people attracted romantically, erotically, and/or emotionally to other female identified people.

**G stands for Gay:** Term used in some cultural settings to represent male identified people who are attracted to other male identified people in a romantic, erotic and/or emotional sense. Also, a term used to refer to the LGBTQIA+ community as a whole or as an individual identity label for anyone who does not identify as heterosexual.

**B stands for Bisexual:** A person emotionally, physically, and/or sexually attracted to people of more than one sex and/or gender. This attraction does not have to be equally split between genders and there may be a preference for one gender over others.

T stands for Transgender: A person who lives as a member of a gender other than that expected based on anatomical sex. Sexual orientation varies and is not dependent on gender identity. This term is sometimes used to refer to the gender variant community as a whole. **Q stands for Queer:** An umbrella term, which embraces a matrix of sexual preferences, orientations, and habits of the not-exclusively-heterosexual-andmonogamous majority. Queer includes lesbians, gays, bisexuals, transpeople, intersex persons, and many other sexually transgressive explorers. The term is sometimes used as a sexual orientation label instead of 'bisexual' as a way of acknowledging that there are more than two genders to be attracted to, or as a way of stating a non-heterosexual orientation without having to state who they are attracted to.

I stands for Intergender: Intergender people have a gender identity that is in the middle between the binary genders of female and male, and may be a mix of both.

A stands for Asexual: A term describing individuals who do not experience sexual attraction or do not have interest in or desire for sex. Asexuality is different from celibacy, which means abstaining from sex. Asexuality is often viewed as a spectrum - meaning there are varying levels and identities regarding someone's emotional, spiritual and romantic attraction. The best way to refer to the asexual community is to use the umbrella term "ace" or "aces" as in the "ace community," which acknowledges that spectrum.

#### + stands for Many Other Identifications

including, but not limited to pansexual, genderqueer, polysexual, agender, androsexual, demisexual, and skoliosexual. We strive to be as inclusive as we can and know we can always improve.
