VISION

Out Front Theatre Company's vision is to strengthen the LGBTQIA+ community in Georgia by exploring and celebrating the universal human experience through the lens of gender and sexuality.

EQUALITY, DIVERSITY, & INCLUSION COMMITMENT

The staff and board of Out Front Theatre Company want to put the following metrics in place so that we can track them to completion. We want our stakeholders and our patrons to see real results.

- We want to have representative board members from black and brown communities, as well as gender nonconforming representatives and increase that representation by at least 10% every year until we reach a goal of above 50%.
- We want to produce, support, or promote at least 2 shows/events from creatives of color every year and increase that number by at least 20% every year.
- We want to increase our presence in communities of color and in women's communities through intentional outreach. We can do this by creating a communication strategy to expand our patronage. To that end, we will recruit a community outreach intern or staff member to help achieve this goal.
- We want to increase our intersectional involvement by partnering with other socially progressive nonprofit organizations to collaborate on community events. The goal is to have at least one partner event per year with an ultimate goal of three per year.

Originally from the Boston area, he holds a BA in English/Writing with a Minor in Theatre from Long Island University in addition to both a MA in Directing from Roosevelt University and a MFA in Directing from the University of Idaho, Select directing credits at Out Front include Priscilla, Queen of the Desert: The Musical, The Most Fabulous Story Ever Told, La Cage aux Folles, Xanadu, Kinky Boots, Ruthless!, Psycho Beach Party, Murder on the Polar Express and most recently the world premiere of Trick! The Musical based on the iconic film of the same name. If you saw Out Front's blockbuster production of

Tide's Gonna Turn

9 to 5 as Musical, Movie, and Movement

Since the dawn of time, workers have hated their bosses. While not everyone has directly dealt with someone like Franklin Hart, Jr. in their own careers. we can all sympathize with the women at the center of 9 to 5. Wouldn't it be nice to just get your boss out of the way for a bit so you can actually get some work done? Especially if your boss is a sexist, egotistical, lying, hypocritical bigot? Since 9 to 5 premiered as a beloved film in 1980, all of its iterations - as a movie, a sitcom, a musical - have spoken to a feeling that's both universal and distinctly American.

9 to 5 is an unmistakably over-the-top comedy, but at its heart is an urgent, political call to action. The real story begins nearly a decade before the movie premiered, with Karen Nussbaum and **Ellen Cassedy**. The two women spent the bulk of their free time like most activists of the era - protesting against the Vietnam War, advocating for Civil Rights, and fighting for social equality for women - while earning a living as office clerks. Their situation was not unique: at the time, one in three working women was an office employee. In a concerted effort to improve workplace conditions, Nussbaum and Cassedy created 9to5 in 1972. What began as a newsletter written for Boston's office workers became a national organization within a



few years, hosting public meetings and addressing issues like low pay, lack of opportunities for advancement, maternity benefits, and sexual harassment in the workplace.

As **9to5**'s reach grew, the organization attracted a particularly high-profile ally: actor and activist Jane Fonda. At this point in her career, Fonda was simultaneously one of the most celebrated actors in the world as well as one of the most controversial political figures of her time, and she was using her clout to produce socially-conscious films. The stories she heard from the women in 9to5 sounded ripe for a movie, so she collaborated with Nussbaum to develop a pitch. Once the project got the greenlight, screenwriter Patricia Resnick was hired to develop a script. The driving force in Resnick's screenplay came from

one **9to5** meeting where Fonda asked a room full of office workers the golden question: "Do any of you fantasize about killing your boss?" With that, 9 to **5** as we know it began to take shape.

The final ingredient in the film's success was the involvement of two of the most famous women in America: groundbreaking comedian Lily Tomlin and country superstar **Dolly Parton**. Like Fonda, Tomlin and Parton were experiencing career highpoints when they starred in 9 to 5, and their supernova fame paired with their chemistry together helped make the film an immediate sensation. The iconic theme song didn't hurt, either. With its throbbing beat, proud lyrics ("Pour myself a cup of ambition"), and rousing chorus, "9 to 5" went on to have a long life of its own, becoming one of the great labor anthems of the 20th century. The film was making a real difference in the way women were being treated in the workplace, but the shift to conservatism in the 1980s stifled

much of the momentum of the women's movement.

Decades later, when Resnick and Parton reunited to collaborate on the musical adaptation of the film, there was one key difference: unlike the original movie, which spoke directly to then-contemporary concerns, the musical is specifically set in the past. Still, as long as workers need solidarity to avoid being exploited, 9 to 5 will remain relevant. We may be dealing with some of the same issues as Violet, Judy, and Doralee, but we are certainly navigating new ones, too (is it possible to kidnap your boss in a gig economy?). As we find ourselves in yet another pendulum swing towards conservatism, 9 to 5 proudly and unapologetically calls for unity, camaraderie, and action against an unjust system. Nussbaum said it best: "We can do more than complain - that's why you need to battle."

Out Front Theatre Company was established to tell stories of the LGBTQIA+ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intergender, Asexual) experience and community, giving voice to LGBTQIA+ authors, composers, artists, and creators through the medium of theatre and the performing arts. Out Front plans to develop new works and produce classic pieces of theatre that have communicated these stories of the LGBTQIA+ population to a wider audience over time.

As a non-profit organization with a dedicated focus to better the LGBTQIA+ population, we strive to:

- Produce established works and premiere productions created by members of the LGBTQIA+ society,
- Generate productions with universal themes which are important to the LGBTQIA+ community,
- Educate the populous to LGBTQIA+ history,
- Work with local and national LGBTQIA+ organizations to bring awareness of issues facing the LGBTQIA+ to the greater Atlanta area,
- Create artistic and educational opportunities for at-risk LGBTQIA+ youths by collaborating with local educational institutions and organizations,
- Expand the number of theatrical opportunities for artists who are members of or who support the LGBTQIA+ community.

Out Front hopes to create a narrative that will reach beyond the stage, into the

conversations and minds our audiences and artists. Theatre's power as a catalyst to spur dialogues goes back thousands of years. Out Front lives to continue that grand tradition of bringing the stories of the LGBTQIA+ people into the spotlight.

LGBTQIA+ Definitions

L stands for Lesbian: Term used to describe female identified people attracted romantically, erotically, and/or emotionally to other female identified people.

G stands for Gay: Term used in some cultural settings to represent male identified people who are attracted to other male identified people in a romantic, erotic and/or emotional sense. Also, a term used to refer to the LGBTQIA+ community as a whole or as an individual identity label for anyone who does not identify as heterosexual.

B stands for Bisexual: A person emotionally, physically, and/or sexually attracted to people of more than one sex and/or gender. This attraction does not have to be equally split between genders and there may be a preference for one gender over others.

T stands for Transgender: A person who lives as a member of a gender other than that expected based on anatomical sex. Sexual orientation varies and is not dependent on gender identity. This term is sometimes used to refer to the gender variant community as a whole.

Q stands for Queer: An umbrella term, which embraces a matrix of sexual preferences, orientations, and habits of the not-exclusively-heterosexual-andmonogamous majority. Queer includes lesbians, gays, bisexuals, transpeople, intersex persons, and many other sexually transgressive explorers. The term is sometimes used as a sexual orientation label instead of 'bisexual' as a way of acknowledging that there are more than two genders to be attracted to, or as a way of stating a non-heterosexual orientation without having to state who they are attracted to.

I stands for Intergender: Intergender people have a gender identity that is in the middle between the binary genders of female and male, and may be a mix of both.

A stands for Asexual: A term describing individuals who do not experience sexual attraction or do not have interest in or desire for sex. Asexuality is different from celibacy, which means abstaining from sex. Asexuality is often viewed as a spectrum - meaning there are varying levels and identities regarding someone's emotional, spiritual and romantic attraction. The best way to refer to the asexual community is to use the umbrella term "ace" or "aces" as in the "ace community," which acknowledges that spectrum.

+ stands for Many Other Identifications

including, but not limited to pansexual, gendergueer, polysexual, agender, androsexual, demisexual, and skoliosexual. We strive to be as inclusive as we can and know we can always improve.






